Part I Line 20 Other Changes in Net Assets

In 1996 Ashoka adopted SFAS 124 and is required to carry its investments at fair value. The \$1,592,217 increase in net assets is the result of recording the unrealized gains of \$88,946 on these investments at 8-31-06 the recording of foreign exchange gains of \$149,620 and the increase in temporarily restricted net assets of \$1,353,651 caused by the reduction in the allowance for a pledge that was considered uncollectible in prior years which was collected.
